

CAMP RULES OF CONDUCT

Dear Event Coordinator,

<u>Please go over these rules of conduct with your group at orientation</u>. Your help in these areas will allow us to preserve a safe and pleasant environment and be a Christian witness to the residents who live around the Laguna Campus. As the leader of your group, it is your responsibility to communicate and enforce these policies to your attendees.

CAMP CURFEWS

- Camp Quiet Time **10 PM** (no shouting, music, megaphone, large group activities)
- Pools, Basketball, Volleyball and Gaga Ball close at **10 PM**
- Guests must be off the beach and within campus boundaries by **11 PM**
- Guests must be in their rooms by 11:30 PM

NOISE VIOLATIONS

Guests are subject to local laws concerning noise dB levels and noise nuisances. This includes your meeting room, any area of the Laguna campus and the public beach.

Noise or music from your meeting room or any part of the Laguna Beach Campus or public beach shall not exceed 70 dBA between the hours of 8 am and 10 pm. Loud bass is not permitted. **If bass can be heard or felt from outside your meeting room at any time, it is too loud.** Loud music/PA systems shall not be used on the public beach.

Camp quiet time is 10 pm. No use of megaphones, amplified music of any kind, shouting, or any large group activities that produce noise greater than 60 dBA. LBCR reserves the right to monitor and adjust dB sound levels and bass to comply with the Bay County Sound Ordinance.

Guests that violate this policy are subject to governmental fines and citations and forfeiting your future reservation at Laguna Beach Christian Retreat.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- Shaving Cream fights, water balloon fights, squirt guns
- Weapons, Drugs, Alcohol, Smoking, Vaping
- Fireworks, Littering
- Bikes, Scooters, and Skateboards on sidewalks
- Running/Hazardous play around swimming pools

BEACH FLAG WARNING SYSTEM

Panama City Beach has a flag warning system to ensure safe swimming in the Gulf of Mexico. Please note the flag color daily and adjust your groups swimming activities in the Gulf. **Text "PCBFLAGS" to 888777 to receive text updates on flag conditions**.

DOUBLE RED FLAGS	Water Closed to Public.
RED FLAG	High Hazard - High Surf and/or Strong Currents
YELLOW FLAG	Medium Hazard - Moderate Surf and/or Currents
PURPLE FLAG	Jellyfish, Stingray, or Dangerous fish present

Safety

- No lifeguards on duty at the Laguna pools or the Gulf of Mexico.
- Groups must provide supervision. Swim at your own risk.
- Guests must use the designated pedestrian crosswalks to cross Front Beach Road to get to the beach.
- Do not allow students to congregate in the side streets that go through the campus. These are public streets used by our local neighbors.

SUPERVISION

Groups shall provide at least one adult chaperone to reside in any room where minors are housed. Also, provide visual/safety supervision in meeting rooms and outdoor recreation areas. Lifeguards are not present at any pools or the Gulf of Mexico. It is the responsibility of the group leader(s) to provide safety and supervision of all swimming pools and the Gulf of Mexico. Please lock your housing rooms when you are at the beach or in meetings. Please instruct your group to use the pedestrian cross walks when going to the beach and to wait for traffic to come to a complete stop before crossing Front Beach Rd. Please be aware of vehicles on the side roads surrounding the Campus. Do not block the street with large groups of students.

MAINTENANCE

Please help us by informing everyone on your staff to report maintenance problems, questions about policies, and requests of any kind to the office, gift shops, or any of our staff on the grounds. TRASH ON BEACH & GROUNDS
